

Delph Traffic Questionnaire

Dear fellow residents

This questionnaire has been organised by local residents who are concerned about the traffic situation and road safety in Delph. Many think that speeding traffic combined with stupid driving and poor sight lines for vehicles at the library crossroads have made the centre of Delph particularly dangerous.

The group is suggesting a number of measures and is asking for your opinion.

1) **20 mph zone.** A 20 mph zone will reduce traffic speed through the village including Millgate and making the Delph library crossroads safer. The 20 mph zone should extend from Delph School on Denshaw Road to The Sound



2) **One-way system on Church Street** Residents have suggested a one way system to ensure access for emergency vehicles which currently have experienced difficulties getting down Church Street.

3) **Additional signage for Delph Bridge** To warn traffic, especially approaching from the Denshaw Road, about the priority system.

4) **Parking on Stoneswood.** Parking on both sides of the road especially at the bottom of the road makes access difficult. Double yellow lines could be extended from the crossroads to around 20 yards beyond the theatre entrance or further on one side of the road.

5) **Crossing outside Delph School** To make it safer to cross Denshaw Road both for school children and for local children outside school hours to get to the playgrounds – including Swan Meadow.

This survey will produce evidence to show Oldham Council what local people want – please fill it in.
